

Indiana Withholding

If you are an Indiana employer, you may be required to withhold county income tax from your employees in addition to withholding Indiana state tax. If you have an employee who **lived or worked** in an adopting county on January 1, 2009 you must withhold tax for that county in 2009. The only Indiana county that has not adopted the county income tax is Lake County.

In 2009, the state will be monitoring the county tax withholding more closely. The reporting form WH-1 has been revised to specify how much tax has been withheld for each county.
